Who is Shoalhaven Community Transport?

We are a community based organisation offering transport to clients who are frail aged, disabled and their carers and people that are transport disadvantaged who reside within the Local Government Area.



Aboriginal Transport

We deliver a culturally appropriate service to clients who are eligible to use our service. We provide transport to medical appointments, hospitals, nursing homes, and events such as NAIDOC Week, Sorry Day, Seniors Week, Yarn Up, Elders Christmas Party and the Survival Concert held every Australia Day.

We can also provide transport to funerals depending on availability of vehicles.



Bookings

Bookings need to be made at least 48 hours prior to appointment and for out of the area transport we require three days' notice.



Costs

We ask a contribution for transport and you will be advised of the amount at the time of your booking.
